ERIN Specific Action Programme for Pakistan

Are you eligible for our support?

If you are a national of Pakistan looking to return after previously seeking asylum in an ERIN partner country, you may be eligible for a reintegration package.

Eligible individuals can be both voluntary and non-voluntary of all ages and include:

- ✓ Asylum-seekers who, having claimed asylum now choose to return home
- ✓ Persons with refugee status, or enjoying temporary protected status, who choose to return home
- ✓ Families with underage children, elderly people and individuals with medical needs
- ✓ Migrants who have not been issued with a deportation, expulsion or removal order
- ✓ Persons whose asylum claim has been rejected
- ✓ Irregular migrants in administrative detention and illegal aliens
- ✓ Victims of trafficking and associated forms of exploitation like forced labour
- ✓ Any person with legal status in the host country, but without means to return home (including, for example, stranded persons and students)

What is a Reintegration Package?

As a Returnee under ERIN specific action programme you may be eligible for a number of Return and Reintegration services provided through IRARA.

Before your departure

Once you have enrolled onto the ERIN programme you will be contacted before you leave by an IRARA representative who will get to know you and will make any necessary arrangements for your arrival in your home country.

When you arrive

You will be met by an IRARA representative who will help you get orientated should you need it. They can help you with organising transport, temporary shelter (max 5 days), guidance and urgent medical needs.

Reintegration

IRARA will also undertake an assessment of your current situation and work with you to develop a Reintegration assistance package that can include things like:

- Technical and Vocational Training
- Job Placement Assistance
- Business Start Up Assistance
- Education
- Medical Facilitation Assistance
- Bespoke Assistance (for vulnerable groups)

The first 12 months

We understand that your needs may change throughout your first year back home and with this in mind we will hold three to four meetings where we will review and adapt the package to ensure the best outcomes for you.
